

Summary of Offering Chart

One item that we have little or no appreciation for is the number of sacrifices which were offered to Jehovah the God of Israel. In Scripture, these was pretty much an on-going constant thing. There were daily sacrifices, Sabbath day sacrifices, monthly sacrifices and sacrifices on special feast days. There is no indication that the daily sacrifice was ever set aside on the Sabbath day or that either of these sacrifices were set aside on any given day of a feast.

Every day	Num. 28:2-3	One lamb was offered in the morning and the other at twilight.	Two male lambs, one year old and without defect.	1/10 of an ephah of fine flour mixed with a fourth of a hin of beaten oil. A fourth of a hin of strong drink for each lamb.
Each Sabbath day	Num. 28:9-10	This was in addition to the offerings above.	Two male lambs, a year old and without defect.	2/10 of an ephah of fine flour mixed with oil. Also a libation was given as well.
Offering of the New Moon Each new month, these offerings were to be made unto God.	Num. 28:11-15		Two bulls, one ram, seven male lambs (one year old and without defect). Also, one goat would be offered as a sin offering along with its libation.	3/10 of an ephah of fine flour mixed with oil for each bull; 2/10 of an ephah of fine flour mixed with oil for the ram; 1/10 of an ephah of fine flour mixed with oil for each lamb. There will be a half a hin of wine for the bull, a third of a hin of wine for the ram and a fourth of a hin of wine for a lamb.
